MINUTES OF THE AUGUST 9TH, 2014 GENERAL MEETING

President Kristopher Skromme called the meeting to order at 12:10pm at the Loma Peloma Building at UCSB **SECRETARY:** (Mayhew) The minutes of the May 18, 2014 meeting in Santa Barbara were read and approved by the membership. (Skromme/Boggs)

TREASURER: (Alford) The Union Bank checking account balance as of 6/30/2014 is \$44,280.49 with \$8,751.17 in the Vision One Credit Union. The total sponsorship income to date is \$16,000 with \$2,000 pending. The total expenses for the first half of the year were \$12,315.23 with an income of \$19,864.92. The 2014 year budget for expenses is \$26,400.00 so we are in good shape. The last continuing education event was about \$2500 more that the average CE because of the high number of attendees but we received about \$760 more in CE fees than average. The treasurer's report was approved by the membership. (Skromme/Marquez).

GOVERNMENTAL AFFAIRS: (Skromme for Gronquist) Joanne and Steve Langsford met with Hillary Blackerby, Das Williams' Senior Field Representative to talk about our bill. She said that they have received emails from ophthalmology to oppose the bill because we will be performing "delicate surgery on the eyes". Joanne assured her that all of the procedures have already been performed by OD's in other states for over 20 years without any increase in complications. All doctors will be fully trained on how to do the procedures. Ophthalmology is in agreement that we are capable of doing the procedures; they just want a 2 to 3 year residency. The language of the bill is as such:

- Specifc didactic and clinical/lab training.

- Experience performing between 44-72 procedures on live patients. This is far beyond what Ophthalmologists are required to complete during their training. This is also more than other states have needed to do.

- Written and hands on practical examination to ensure competency

- The training program would be developed in consultation with an ophthalmologist educator.

The Bill will be heard in Assembly Appropriations in the first couple weeks of August. If passed, it will move on to the Assembly floor by the end of the month. We will be the first State to do immunizations. We will gain lumps and bumps. Diabetes, Hypertension and Cholesterol treatment is off the table.

PRESIDENT ELECT: (Craig) We are currently working on sponsors and speakers for October at the Cliffs in Pismo. The COA credentialing is under way.

We are trying to make the web site more interactive so everyone can sign up for CE online.

VICE PRESIDENT: (Thompson) Melinda is getting sponsors and keeping track of them on the updated Excel sheets. We will also be getting in touch with members to update their e-mails and phone numbers.

MEMBERSHIP: (Lowry) We have seven new members in the TCOS. All members should invite a non-member to lunch to let them know what the COA can do for them.

VISIONARY: (RUIZ) Pictures are on the web site from the last meeting and events. Check them out.

PRESIDENT: (Skromme)

-We have a new Step and Repeat stand for the meetings and a few new name badges for those individuals who did not get one. -The TCOS was selected to choose a representative to serve on the Presidents' Council at the recent COA HOD. The HOD wanted to stagger the terms so that there are veteran members on the committee. There will be one and two year terms. The responsibilities are: the committee will meet four to five times via conference call to plan and structure the event. -Save the Dates:
